

## SPREAD THE WORD ABOUT CERVICAL CANCER

### HOW MUCH DO YOU KNOW ABOUT CERVICAL CANCER?

In Singapore, Cervical Cancer is the 10th most common cancer for women.

Cervical Cancer does not typically cause noticeable symptoms in the early stages. Therefore, regular cervical screening in the form of a Pap Smear (once in 2 to 3 years) is important for women who are sexually active.

When a Pap Smear result shows abnormalities, the woman is advised to go for a Colposcopy for a closer inspection of the cervix.

### COLPOSCOPY AT CONCORD INTERNATIONAL HOSPITAL

A Colposcopy is a simple procedure which allows our specialist to examine your cervix.

During the procedure, a speculum will be inserted into the vagina and the specialist will examine the cervix through a colposcope. Tissue samples can be obtained and sent to test for cancer cells.
