

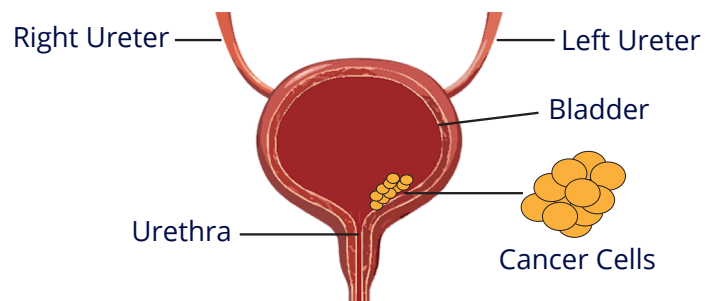
FIGHT BLADDER CANCER

WHEN SHOULD YOU SEE A DOCTOR?

Other symptoms might include frequent urination, pain during urination or lower back pain.

Cystoscopy is a procedure whereby a small tube (cystoscope) with a lens passes through the urethra and slowly advances into the bladder. This procedure allows the doctor to examine the lining of your bladder. Both urine and tissue samples can be obtained from the bladder and sent to test for cancer cells.
